The candle was sponsored this week by Joan, Andrew, & Ian Hakes in loving memory of Russ.



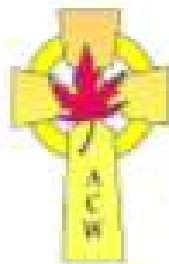
