As well as CBC radios "Madly Off in All Directions", The "Edmonton Comedy Festival" and opening for Bob Saget and acclaimed musician Jeff Beck. you may recognize Kevin from his hosting duties on Global TV's "Inside Entertainment", Sun Networks "The DVD Show", TV Tropolis "Where are They Now" and Shaw TV's "Movie Reviews with Kevin Stobo". Kevin Stobo was a finalist in the 2002 Just For Laughs "HOMEGROWN COMPETITION" and has appeared on the Just For Laughs television show. Kevin has also appeared in several national television commercials including Subway and Telus. He was a recurring character on the television series "Honey I Shrank The Kids". Kevin is a natural at his craft. He has been touring and performing stand-up comedy ever since high school.
