

It was a beautiful way to pay tribute to such a phenomenal lady and YOU made it happen. All of our walkers and all of you who sponsored participants made it a success! When registering a team online they ask that your team set a goal to raise \$1500 - I set ours at \$2500 and you blew it out of the water! At the time of the walk, together we had raised \$4,875.00 for the Parkland Food Bank! That's right, we raised 195% of our fundraising goal - very well done!

Our own Karen Adlem was recognized at the event for joining the 1K fundraising club as an individual who raised over a thousand dollars on her own. Karen actually collected over two thousand dollars!






Many got their ashes in the chapel!
