Thanks to all who participated making it a truly beautiful service!



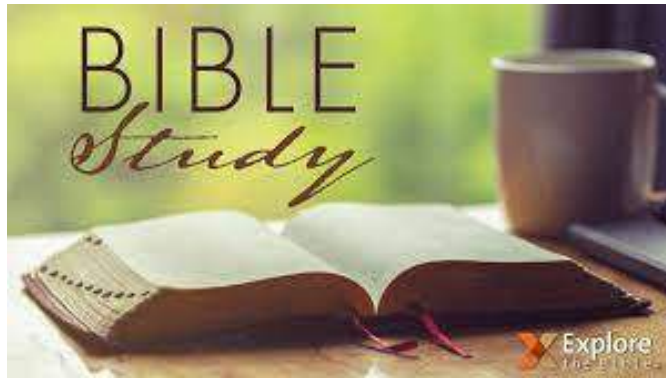
