\*\* all items are available at the dollar store, they've even had cake mixes that only require water to mix \*\*

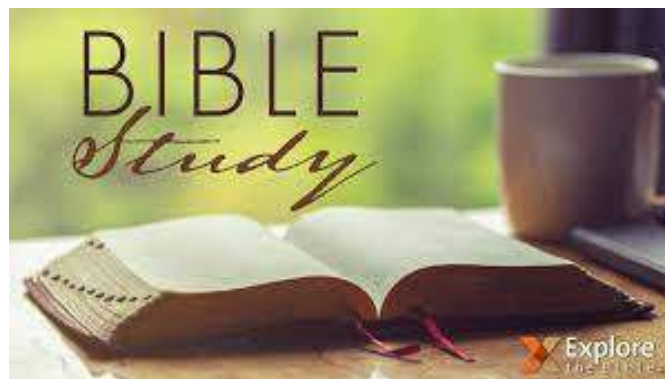
\*\* Gluten free cake mixes are helpful as well! \*\*
