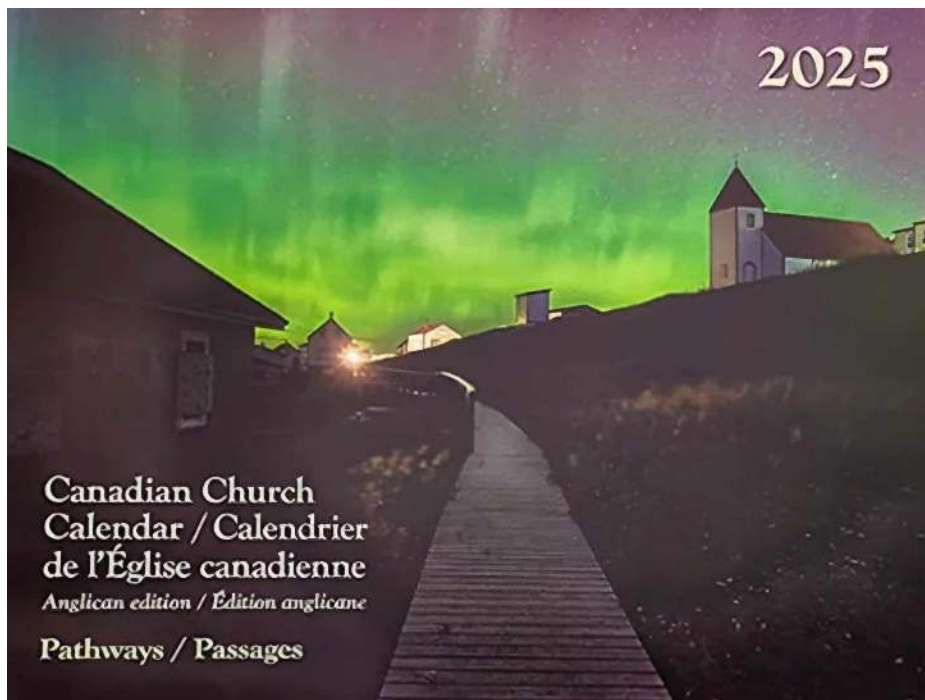


ANGLICAN CHURCH WOMEN

ACW Autumn Gathering

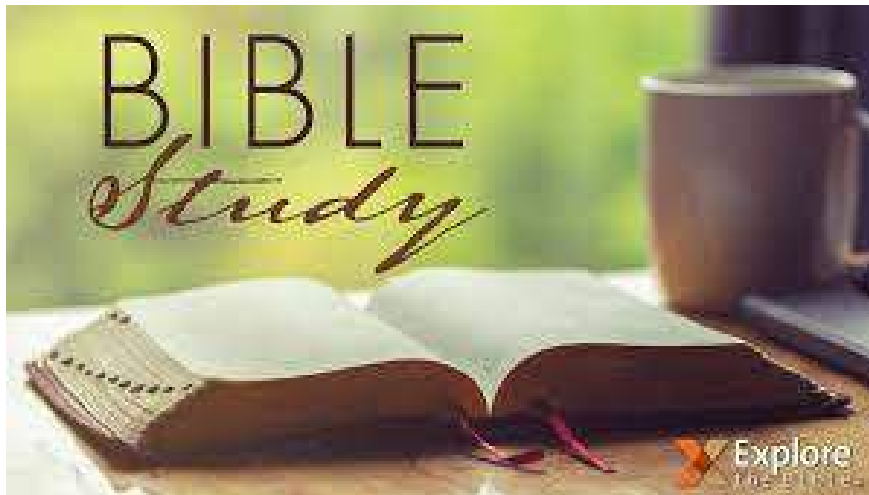
The ladies of St. Augustine's Parkland invite all women of the Edmonton Diocese to a day of visiting and fun on Saturday, September 21, 2024.

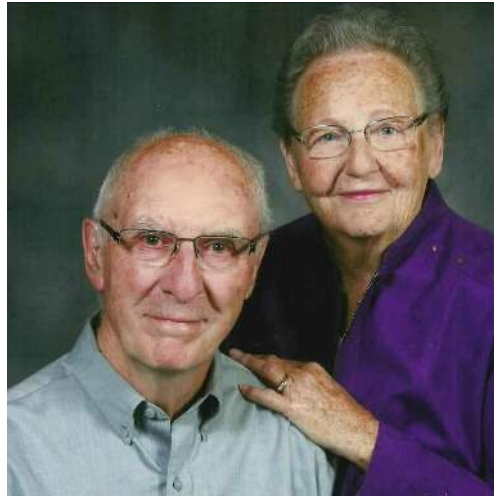

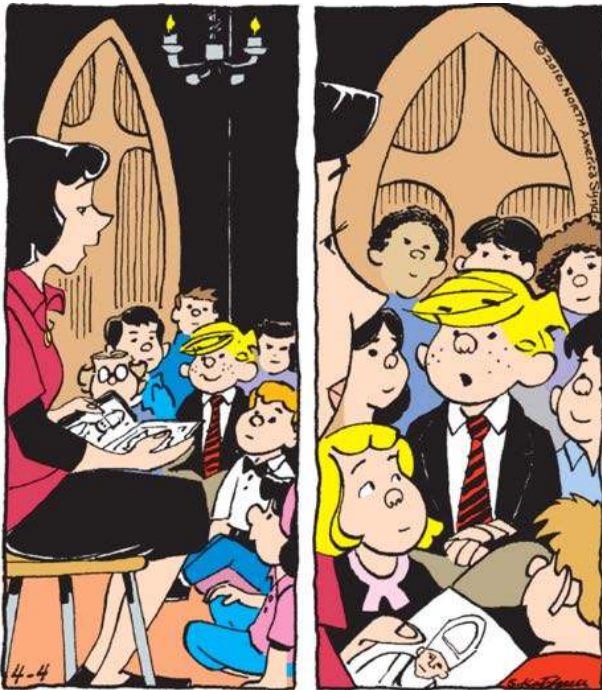
