Saturday, December 7<sup>th</sup>: Christmas Cursillo Ultreya at St. Augustine's Parkland!

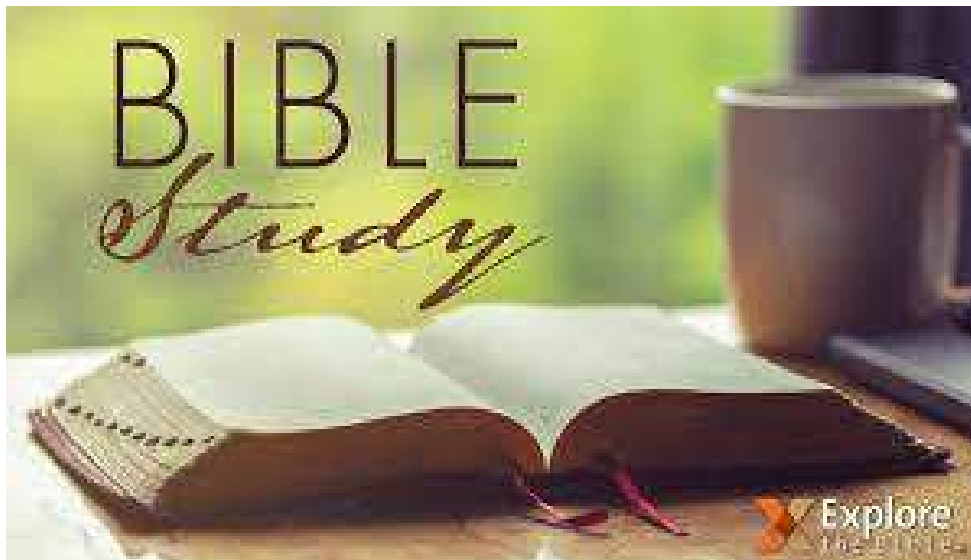
