- In our own parish this week, we pray for Maria, Bev, Elizabeth, Cathay, Edie; and their families.

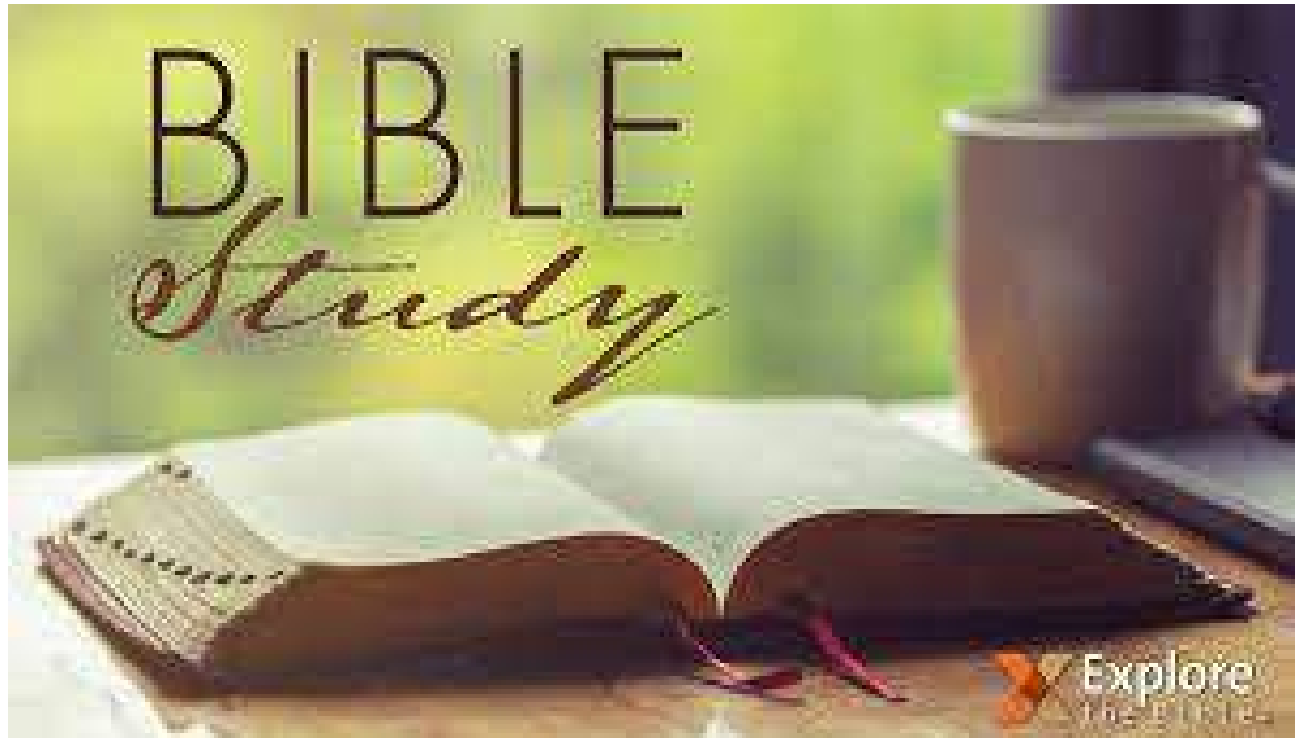
Please note: Submitted names will be kept on the prayer list for a period of two weeks unless intentionally renewed.
