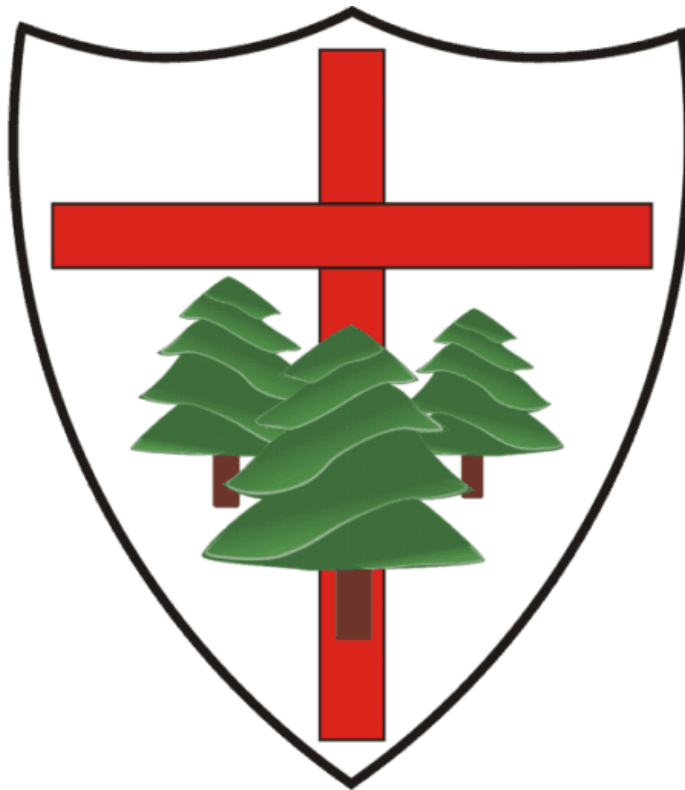

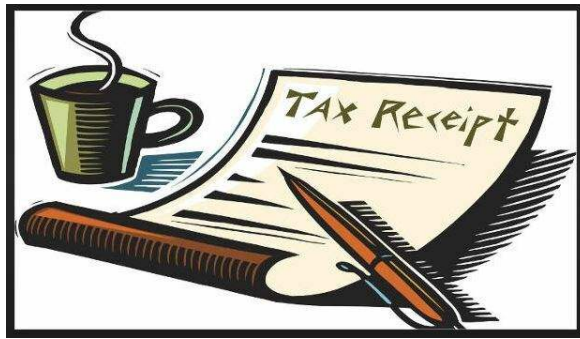
Tabernacle Candle:

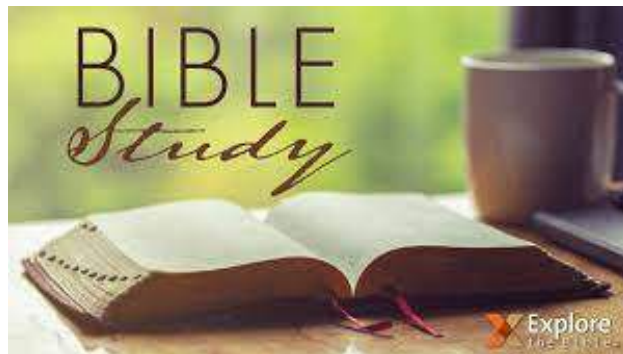
