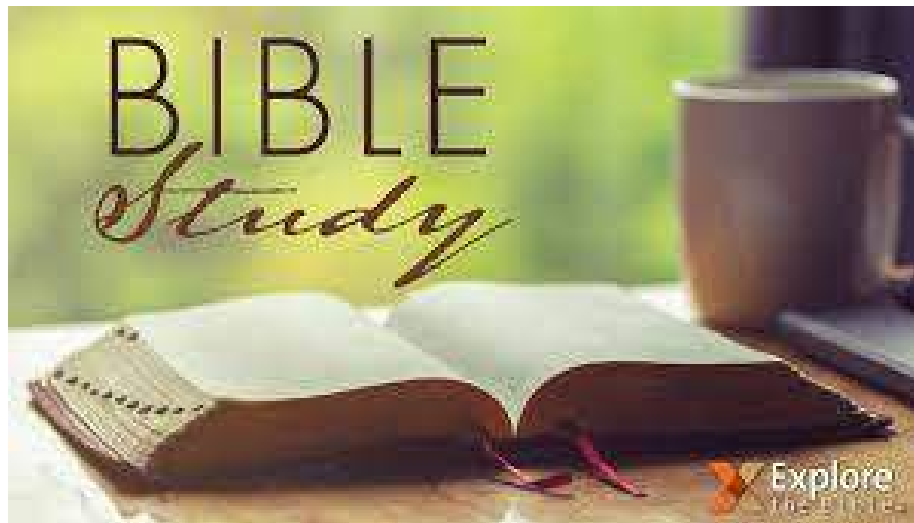

Bible Study!

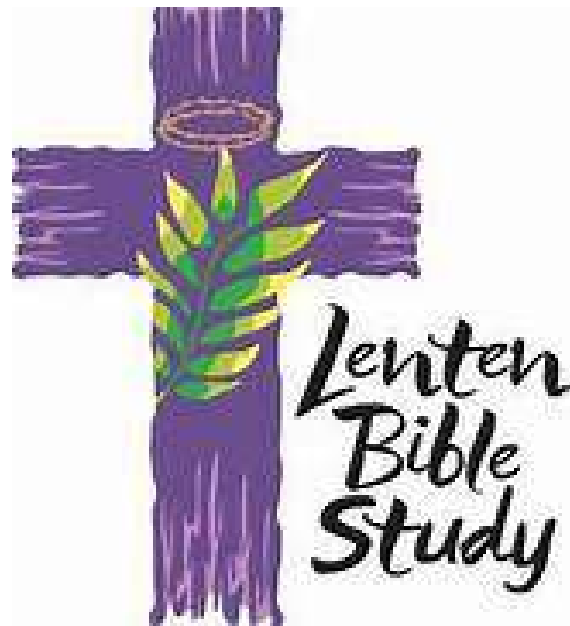
