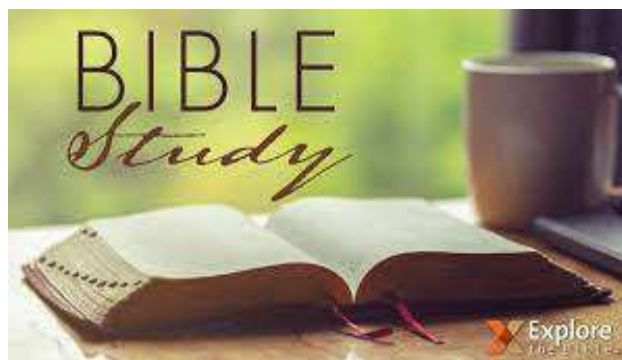
***Please remember in your prayers this week:***

### ***Bible Study!***

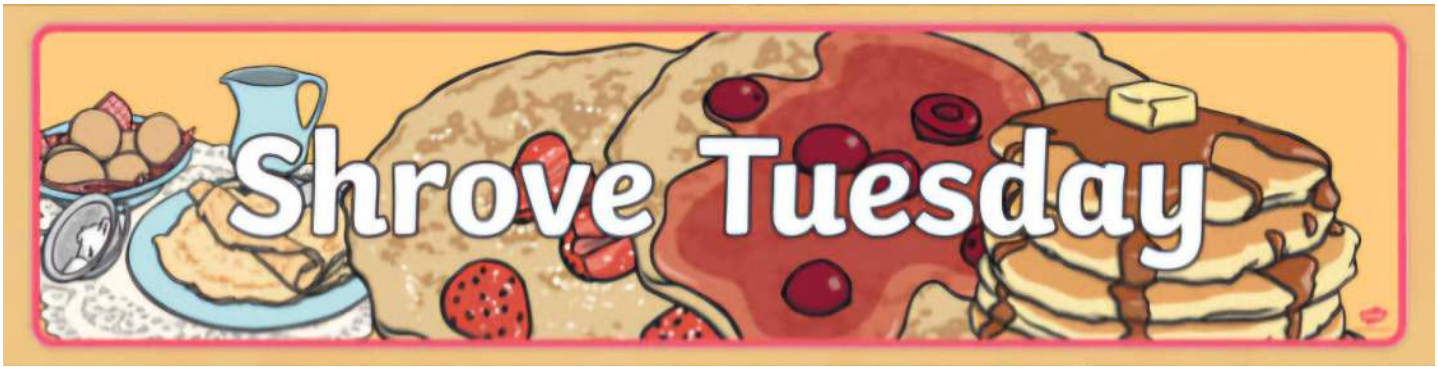
