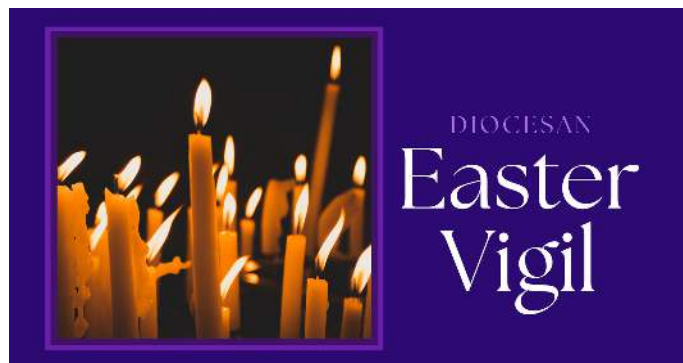
We'll meet at 9:00 am at the Fresh Grill in Stony Plain - 5103 50 Street, south of the roundabout on the east side of the street.

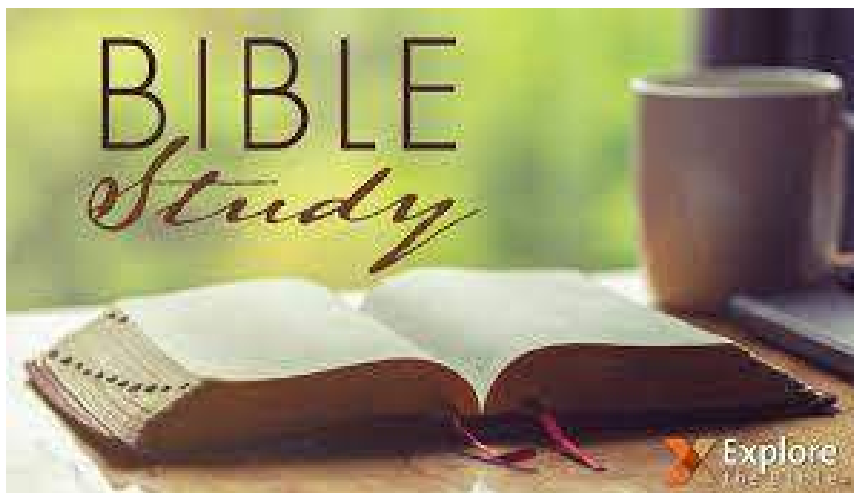
