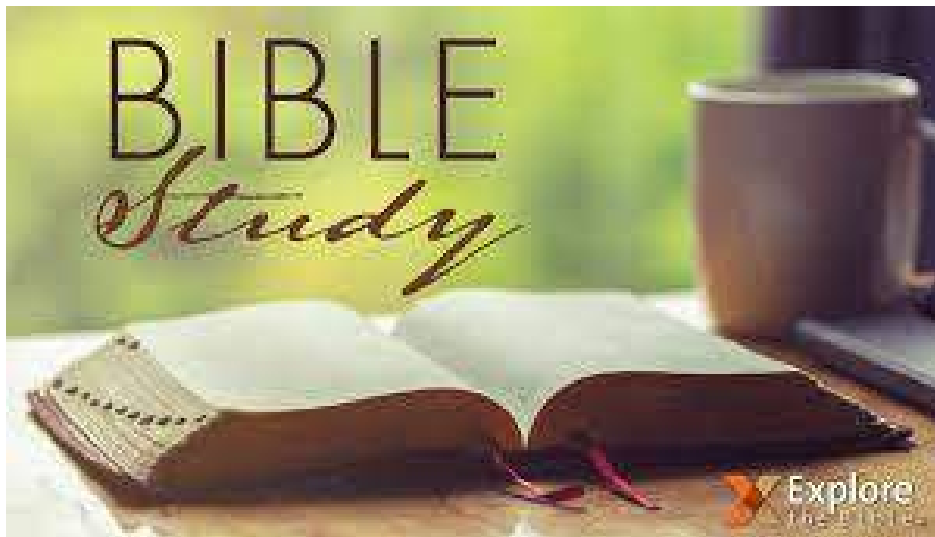


ANGLICAN CHURCH WOMEN
